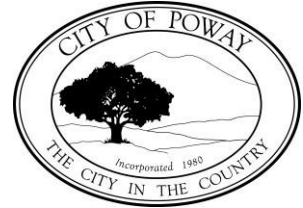

Temporary Use Permit (TUP) – Block Party



CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL

Any citizen of Poway who is over the age of 18 may apply for a Block Party permit. The City of Poway will furnish barricades and authorize closure of the street if certain conditions are met.

1. The street to be blocked cannot be one that is normally used within the tract for through traffic. Cul-de-sacs and stem streets are acceptable. If there is any doubt, contact the Department of Safety Services at (858) 668-4400.
2. The head of the household and/or spouse of all residences affected by the barricades must be contacted and must sign the application form. If a house is unoccupied or the residents are on vacation, the address shall be entered and the condition of the residence ("Unoccupied" or "On Vacation") shall be noted in place of the signature.
3. It will be the responsibility of the applicant, upon approval of the permit, to obtain the required traffic control devices by rental through traffic control supply companies or from the City of Poway's Operation's Center. The center is open from 7:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. from Monday through Friday and they can be contacted at (858) 668-4700. It is also the responsibility of the applicant to return the barricades by noon of the third day after the event. If it becomes necessary for the City to pick up the barricades, there will be a fifty-five-dollar (\$55.00) fee charged to the applicant.
4. No Person shall discharge any material and or liquid into storm drains. For special events, storm drains shall be covered and or protected to the maximum extent practicable. Best Management Practices (BMPs) may be required to ensure that trash is contained and disposed of appropriately. Liquids shall be placed in secondary containment and covered prior to a rain event. Pet waste shall be collected and placed in trash cans.
5. Do not block emergency vehicle access. It is the responsibility of the applicant to place only the prescribed barricades to block any normal vehicle traffic.
6. Streets barricaded or blocked off for a temporary activity shall have barricades manned at all times to allow for emergency vehicle access. The barricades can be placed at 7:00 a.m. and must be removed by 10:00 p.m.
7. The street shall be cleaned and cleared of any debris, which was caused by said block party. If any damage occurs to any City property, said applicant shall be responsible for the cost of replacement and/or repair.
8. For the information of the applicant and residents affected, the following sections from the applicable State Code are quoted:
415 PENAL CODE; DISTURBING THE PEACE
Every person who maliciously and willfully disturbs the peace of quiet of any neighborhood or person, by loud or unusual noise, or by tumultuous or offensive conduct, or threatening, traducing, quarreling, challenging to fight, or fighting, or use any vulgar, profane or indecent language within the presence or hearing of women or children, in a loud and boisterous manner, is guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction by any court or competent jurisdiction, shall be punished by fine not exceeding two hundred dollars, or by imprisonment in the county jail for not more than ninety days, or by both fine and imprisonment, or either, at the discretion of the Court. – 1877
25658 BUSINESS & PROFESSION CODE; SALE OR PURCHASE BY MINOR
Any person under the age of 21 years who has any alcoholic beverage in his possession on any street or highway, or in any public place or in any place open to the public is guilty of a misdemeanor. This section does not apply to possession by a person under the age of 21 making a delivery of an alcoholic beverage in pursuance of the order of his parent or in pursuance of his employment. Amended Stats. 1963, Chapt. 396.
9. In case of problems, the applicant and the residents affected must agree to follow the direction of deputies from the San Diego County Sheriff's Department.
